- ❖ *Thank you to the University Leadership and members of the UAC/CORE Competency Coordinators for their unwavering support, professionalism, flexibility, and due diligence in ensuring the University Assessment Process drives organizational improvement. As the DIE described in the meeting, not every University is so fortunate, and it is you that makes this process work.*

- ❖ In discussing the April 19, Strategic Planning Team (SPT) meeting minutes, the Director of Institutional Effectiveness (DIE) asked that the April 19, 2022 minutes be reviewed in the spring as a reminder of the lessons learned for preparing annual assessment reports.

- ❖ AC 2021-2022 Degree Program, Unit and Core Competency Assessments.
 - The University is at 99% - 158 of 160, Assessment Reports Submitted
 - The DIE provided a separate document with lessons learned and reminders for use in preparing AC 2022-2023 Assessment Reports. See - Things to consider for AC 2022-2023
 - If a coordinator is transitioning out of the position, please inform the DIE, provide the replacement's name and contact information, and use the Coordinator Transition Checklist.
 - Coordinators are asked to submit any name changes of those responsible for individual assessment reports to the DIE so the AC 2022-2023 Assessment Report Tracker can be updated.
 - Before the meeting, the DIE sent the initial analysis of AC 2021-2022 Academic Program, Unit, and Core Competency Assessments. The results reflect quantitative improvement; the University is a learning institution and successfully executing its mission.
 - The DIE highlighted the significant improvement in the Core Competency assessments. Dr. Handel took the opportunity to explain the University of Louisiana System (ULS) Core Competency initiative. Although the naming convention is the same, the ULS initiative is much broader. It defines the

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essential skills our graduates develop at the Universities of Louisiana, no matter the degree program. That our efforts support this overarching framework. See - <https://www.ulsystem.edu/faculty-staff/core-competencies/>
