

Areas of Concentration

Adult-Gerontology Nursing

The clinical sequence in Adult-Gerontology Nursing has two functional areas as options: education and administration. Students who pursue the Adult-Gerontology Nursing sequence will take the MSN core courses, 2-3 clinical courses, and electives to support the functional role chosen. This curriculum option will prepare graduate nurses for the practice of advanced nursing, such as to function as educators in institutions of higher education or as administrators in clinical nursing settings. The program of studies leading to the MSN, with the clinical focus in Adult-Gerontology Nursing requires a minimum of 39 credits. The Adult-Gerontology nursing student will complete a professional paper in lieu of thesis.
