Maternal Child and Family Nursing

The clinical sequence in Maternal Child and Family Nursing has two functional areas: education and administration. The clinical sequence in Maternal Child and Family Nursing at the graduate level will prepare nurses for the practice of advanced nursing as educators in institutions of higher education or as administrators in client care settings. The program of studies leading to the MSN with a clinical focus in Maternal Child and Family Nursing requires a minimum of 39 credits for completion. The Maternal Child and Family nursing student will complete a professional paper in lieu of thesis.
