#### Northwestern's Student Technology Fee Committee

Northwestern's Student Technology Fee Committee was established in the summer of 1997. The Committee includes the Student Government Association Presidents and Treasurers from the Natchitoches and Shreveport campuses, a student representative from the Leesville campus, and two other student representatives appointed by the Natchitoches SGA President. It is the charge of The SGA President (STAT Chair) coordinates meetings as required. The mission statement of the Student Technology Advisory Team states:

The mission of the Student Technology Advisory Team is to ensure that all students have easy access to technologies that are necessary to adequately prepare them to successfully compete in the job market. The Student Technology Fee is a student self-assessed fee that should be used exclusively to the direct benefit of the students. In addition, students should have the primary role in the governance and allocation of these funds.

#### Progress made during 2021-2022

A total of \$1,066,780 was collected during the Fiscal Year 2021-2022, producing an available sum of \$2,712,770. Expenditures for 2021-2022 were \$933,095.

The following is a summary of significant projects and expenditures:

Instructional Technology Lab Assistants/Coordinators, Instructional Technology Technical Support Specialist, and Associate Director - \$228,781.

Computer lab equipment, technology projects (large and small), software, supplies, infrastructure, and maintenance cost included - \$704,314.

Instructional Technology assistants and coordinators were utilized in multiple capacities through this past year, some of which include:

- Staffing and keeping supplies on hand for all open computer labs
- The STAT and Student Support web sites were maintained
- The Student Help Desk assisted students with username account assistance, Moodle, wireless network access, software related issues, Microsoft 365, WebEx and Teams
- Professional development is conducted at the beginning of each semester for all Student Technology Fee lab assistants
- Student Technology Fee workers must attend the annual university training and learn new lab procedures and maintain a working knowledge of services
- Computer lab hour contact information and maps are posted to the website for viewing and workstation availability
