**COMPUTER AND NATURAL SCIENCE (734C):**

biology (BIOL), chemistry (CHEM), computer information systems (CIS), computer science (CSC), educational technology (ETEC), geology (GEOL), mathematics (MATH), physics (PHYS), science (SCI).

**SOCIAL SCIENCE (734G):**

addiction studies (AS), anthropology (ANTH), criminal justice (CJ), economics (ECON), education (EDUC), educational psychology (EPSY), geography (GEOG), history (HIST), pre-law and paralegal studies (PLPS), philosophy (PHIL), political science (PSCI), psychology (PSYC), sociology (SOC), social studies (SST), social work (SOWK), special education (SPED), unified public safety administration (UPSA).

**Communication (3 hours):** 3 hours selected from Business Administration 2200; Communication 1010, 2500; or Philosophy 1010.

**Mathematics (6 hours):** (taken in pairs indicated and in sequence): Mathematics 1020 and 1060; 1020 and 1090; 1020 and 2010; 1035 and 1060; 1100 (6 hours); 1810 (6 hours); or 2100 and 2110 (10 hours).

**Natural Sciences (9 hours):**

- **Physical:** 3 or 6 hours selected from Chemistry 1030, 1040, 1070; Physics 2030; or Science 1010, 2010.
- **Biological:** 3 or 6 hours selected from Biology 1010, 2250, 2260; or Science 1020, 2020.
