

Testing—User Overrides

Setting a User Override

Sometimes, you might need to change a quiz setting for a particular use or users because of specific circumstances. An example of this would be if a student needed extended time on a quiz.

To set up a user override:

Login to Moodle and navigate to the course.

Locate and click on the quiz link.

Use the editing drop down menu and select User overrides.
