Changing the Gradebook Aggregation—Weighted/Natural

Login to Moodle and navigate to the course.

Click on Course Management .



Under Course Settings, choose Gradebook setup.

The default aggregation is set to “Natural.”

To change the aggregation, use the Aggregation drop down menu and select Weighted Mean of Grades.

Weighted Mean of Grades—Setting Weights

After changing the aggregation to weighted mean of grades, you will need to set the weights for grade items and/or grade categories.

Type in the amount you want the grade item and/or category.

Save changes.

Notice that Moodle will place a check mark in the box to the left of weight, “Weighted mean of grades” will be displayed under the category total and the total will be 100. This designates a weighted gradebook.
