

2023-2024 Verification Worksheet Federal Student Aid Programs

Your FAFSA application was selected for review by the U.S. Dept. of Education for a process called verification. In this process NSU must compare information from your FAFSA with the documentation supplied to our office. We must collect all information before you can be awarded any type of Title IV aid. If there are differences between your FAFSA and the other documents you supply, additional information may be requested and corrections may need to be submitted. Your financial aid will not be processed until this form has been completed, returned, and verified.

- 1. Complete all sections and sign the worksheet you must sign the worksheet.
- 2. Submit <u>all</u> required documents to the Office of Financial Aid. Student may visit their MY NSU <u>my.nsula.edu</u> to view all required documents. <u>All</u> required documents must be received on or prior to the last day of the semester by which you are attending.
- 3. If you, the student or spouse (if married) did not use the IRS Tax Retrieval process or you made changes after the IRS Retrieval, contact the IRS at www.irs.gov or call 1-800-908-9946 to obtain a 2021 tax transcript.
- 4. If you, the student or spouse (if married) did not file and/or is not required to file an IRS 1040, you must affirm that you are not required to file an IRS 1040 and include a copy of <u>all</u> 2021 W2 Forms from <u>all</u> employers, if applicable. In all cases you and/or spouse (if married) must provide verification of non-tax filing from the IRS or other relevant tax authority dated on or after October 1, 2022 that indicates that a 2021 IRS 1040 was not filed. The verification of non-filing can be requested by submitting a 4506-T Form (option 7) to the IRS. See www.irs.gov to obtain the 4506-T tax form.
