
## Policies for the Office of Student Financial Aid



FSEOG - Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant Program. Priority is given to those students who have a complete file by the priority deadline. The average award for FSEOG is \$1000 per year.

## Eligibility Requirements-

- 1. Meet citizenship requirements
- 2. Not be in default or owe a refund on any Title IV funds
- 3. Have a processed ISIR on file that demonstrates financial need
- 4. Recipient of a Pell Grant priority given to those students with the lowest EFC.
- 5. Enrolled at an eligible institution in an eligible program leading to a degree
- 6. Have not received a Bachelor's Degree
- 7. Maintain satisfactory academic progress
- 8. Earned a high school diploma or GED
- 9. Not incarcerated in a federal or state penal institution
- 10. Attempting at least 6 hours.

## Awarding of FSEOG-

- 1. Students must have completed the Title IV aid application process as defined in the application section of this manual.
- 2. Verification status must be completed if selected
- 3. The packaging system will award the eligible amount of FSEOG
- 4. FSEOG may also be awarded on a case by case basis using a computer generated report of students with greatest need, if all funds are not awarded through the automated packaging system.
- 5. RPEDISB is the program used to feed FSEOG to the student accounts
