

## PLPS TWO-YEAR PLANNED ROTATION

The chart on the next page shows the planned rotation. An explanation:

- All regular courses have a **regular** rotation, highlighted **green**, which will be available and can be relied on to be available to you. Every regular course is offered at least two years, meaning that if you plan properly you will be able to complete the program in a maximum of two years.
- Some courses are being offered for additional sections on an experimental basis, highlighted **yellow**. These offerings may be removed if not enough students enroll. Do NOT rely on an experimental planned offering to graduate, as there is a chance these will not meet enrollment requirements and will have to be canceled.
- All regular course offerings will be available both online and in-person except CJ 3070, which will be offered synchronously. CJ 3070 counts for PLPS credit because it has a PLPS student track.
- Sometimes students request special courses, such as the civil rights movement and the law sequence. These courses are not guaranteed to be offered again. If you want to take them, take them when they are scheduled!

REQUIREMENTS TO COMPLETE FOR 2019 CATALOG: 3010, 4020, 4090, 12 hours of choosing from remaining courses for minor/concentration (15 hours of choosing for certificate).

REQUIREMENTS TO COMPLETE FOR PRIOR CATALOG YEARS: 3020, 3030, 3040, 3050, 3070, and three (3) Elective PLPS Course Choices (Take all three for Certificate; take two of three for Minor and/or Concentration): 3010, 3060, 3080.

*Sophomore status before beginning is required as is basic computer literacy and solid writing skills. See the PLPS Advisor every semester for advising, as new courses may be offered, and this rotation may be changed.*
