### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

- Must be a minority male.
- Must come from an under-served, socioeconomically disadvantaged, and/or educationally at-risk community.
- Must enroll at Northwestern State University (NSULA).
- Must major in Early Childhood Education, Elementary Education, Health & Physical Education, or Music Education. Secondary Education will also be considered.

### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING**

2. Submit the following to Mrs. Brittany Blackwell Broussard at [blackwellb@nsula.edu](mailto:blackwellb@nsula.edu).
  - Completed Call Me MISTER Program application (below).
  - Two letters of recommendation: one letter from an educator or administrator representing the last school attended **and** one letter from a person who can describe your involvement in the community and/or potential for entering the teaching profession.
  - An essay entitled "Why I Want to Teach" (250-300 words) to address your motivation for entering the teaching profession and the contributions you hope to make to the profession and the community as a teacher.
  - An essay entitled "Why I should be accepted into the Call Me MISTER Program" (250-300 words).
  - A signed statement from a counselor or school official certifying you come from an under-served, underprivileged or socioeconomically disadvantaged background or area.
  - Most recent official high school and/or college transcript.
3. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Information is available at: <https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/fafsa>.
