Comprehensive Summary for 2016

Student Learning Outcomes were measured using both objective and subjective data by various course assignments, projects, exams, and student satisfaction survey (Graduate Exit Survey or Skyfactor [formerly EBI]) related to the DNP program objectives. All SLO expected outcomes were met. The Skyfactor assessment is measured on a 7 point scale. Each question evaluated had a mean of \geq 6.6 and was well above the comparison utilized.
