MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN NORTHWESTERN STATE UNIVERSITY OF LOUISIANA AND

Southern University at Shreveport

Northwestern State University of Louisiana (NSULA) and Southern University at Shreveport (SUSLA) have agreed to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding for an articulation program between the two institutions. The articulation program will allow graduates of SUSLA polysomnography technology program to complete the first two years of study at SUSLA and transfer all credit hours as designated in Appendix A to NSULA for completion of the Bachelors of Applied Science in Allied Health (BASAH). Students transferring to NSULA may complete the last two years of their coursework at NSULA. Both institutions serve constituency needs and are responsive, student-oriented institutions that prepare the students to become productive members of society as well as promote the academic development and improvement in the quality of life of citizens in their regions.

This partnership is mutually beneficial to both institutions for several reasons:

- SUSLA traditional and non-traditional students will have the opportunity after completing the Associat of Applied Science in Polysomnographic Technology degree at SUSLA to transfer to the BASAH program that will accept SUSLA credits.
- NSULA will have the opportunity to accept students into the BASAH Program who are well-prepared with the foundational course work.
- Both NSULA and SUSLA are accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC).
- Both NSULA and SUSLA have full-time faculty with advanced academic and professional credentials and both have support resources (i.e. library, Internet access, and adequate administrative-faculty-staff support).

In accordance with this Memorandum of Understanding, SUSLA agrees to:

- Provide academic advising to Polysomnographic Technology students who plan to transfer to NSULA according to agreements in Appendix A.
- Provide students the opportunity to obtain the SUSLA credit hours as listed in Appendix A of the Memorandum of Understanding between NSULA and SUSLA.
- Provide information about the articulation Agreement in the SUSLA General Catalog.
- Jointly market the articulation agreement with NSULA

In accordance with this Memorandum of Understanding, Northwestern State University of Louisiana agrees to:

• Receive and maintain Intent to Transfer forms from SUSLA students and honor the agreement regarding academic catalog in effect on the date of the student's signature and the NSULA confirmation signature. (Appendix B).

- Accept SUSLA credit hours as listed in Appendix A of the Memorandum of Understanding between NSULA and SUSLA.
- Provide SUSLA with copies of the NSULA Application for Admission into the Bachelor of Applied Science in Allied Health and other advising materials.
- Provide information about the articulation Agreement in the Northwestern State University of Louisiana catalog.
- Jointly market the articulation agreement with SUSLA.

By signature of Dr. Marcus Jones, President Northwestern State University of Louisiana and signature of Dr. Aubra Gantt, Chancelor Southern University at Shreveport, this articulation Memorandum of Understanding is entered into on the <u>1st of October</u> 2023.

This agreement may be revised only with the signatures of the leaders of both institutions.
