Master of Music Admission Requirements

Master of Music with a concentration in Music Education (542A):

- Bachelor's degree in music minimum and earned from a regionally accredited college or university with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.75. Bachelor's degree in music education and teacher certification preferred.
- Graduate Record Examination (GRE) OR Application Portfolio. *
- Two written letters of recommendation from music education professionals that attest to the applicant's preparedness for graduate study in music education.
- Letter of Intent (500 words minimum) that discusses the applicant's goals and reasons for
 pursuing the Master of Music with a concentration in Music Education Degree, and how their
 graduate study at NSU fits into their plan.
- Highly recommended that applicants without a valid teaching license pursue alternate certification concurrent with their master's program.

*Candidates for admission must submit either GRE scores or an Application Portfolio.

GRE: minimum of 282 on verbal plus quantitative sections (preferred).

Application Portfolio:

- 1. Resume/curriculum vita (CV)
- 2. Writing sample of not more than 15 pages demonstrating facility in analysis, argument, research, and coherence.

Master of Music Admission Requirements

Master of Music with a concentration in Music Performance (542B)

- Bachelor's degree in music minimum and earned from a regionally accredited college or university with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.75. Bachelor's degree in music performance preferred.
- Graduate Record Examination (GRE) OR Application Portfolio. *
- Two written letters of recommendation from music education professionals that attest to the applicant's preparedness for graduate study in music performance.
- Demonstrate ability and accomplishment in the proposed major field and in applied music through a live audition before at least two graduate music faculty members. The demonstrated performing proficiency must be equal to that required in the Bachelor of Music in Performance at NSU. For voice applicants, any deficiency in language/diction skills must be satisfied prior to comprehensive exam/final project.
 - *Candidates for admission must submit either GRE scores or an Application Portfolio.

GRE: minimum of 282 on verbal plus quantitative sections (preferred).

Application Portfolio:

- 1. Resume/curriculum vita (CV)
- Letter of Intent (500 words minimum) that discusses the applicant's goals
 and reasons for pursuing the Master of Music with a concentration in Music
 Performance Degree, and how their graduate study at NSU fits into their
 plan.
- Writing sample of not more than 15 pages demonstrating facility in analysis, argument, research, and coherence.
- 4. Repertoire List.
