### Re: Updating Nursing Skills lab

As the Nursing Skills Lab Coordinator at the Shreveport campus, it is imperative that we provide the nursing students with an updated environment that reflects the clinical settings. This lab has not had any updates for over 10 - 15 years.

These requested upgrades will provide each student, from 1<sup>st</sup> level to 5<sup>th</sup> level, the use of essential and daily equipment and supplies, that affect patient care and outcomes. It is important for students to have the hands-on ability to use the equipment in a repetitive and memorable experience, for preparation to real-life patient care. Currently, we do not have the quantity of equipment, nor up-todate, to provide for our student census. For FY2022-2023, we had approximately 200 BSN and ASN Nursing Programs that utilized the Shreveport Skills lab.

It is our philosophy in the Clinical Lab setting that nursing students are better prepared and more confident, which is a direct reflection of our institution and the nursing profession, when they are provided with the essential tools, including book knowledge and collection of patient clinical values from essential equipment.

Our objectives include upgrading and improving access to technology used in the clinical setting, in which, students are evaluated by competency testing on each of the specific aspects of patient care, for a total of 6 graded, hands-on demonstration testing.

These objectives include competency testing for the following:

- 1. Vital signs including accessing pulse, respiration, temperature and B/P
- 2. Central line/wound dressing change
- 3. Medications including preparation, administration, evaluating, patient education and documentation.

- 4. Foley all aspects of urinary elimination, including insertion, discontinuation, patient education and documentation.
- 5. Physical assessment complete head-to-toe patient assessment and documentation.
- 6. Comprehensive competency includes all of the above ,utilizing critical thinking skills to identify patient needs and ability to prioritize.

The equipment that needs to be available, along with updating, includes the following:

- 1. Vital signs monitoring currently only have 1 mobile V/S machine which has now become obsolete and will no longer take the B/P.
- 2. Headwalls to include Oxygen, air, and suction capabilities. Currently, I only have 6. These are standard patient equipment in every patient room and the lab should reflect this expectation for practicing.
- 3. IV pumps- Currently, I only have 2. These pumps are essential and students need to learn how to use these in an precise and confident manner.
- 4. Sequential Compression Device (SCD) Currently, I only have 1 and it is very old. These have become standard practice too since the patient's chance of an emboli increases during their hospital stay.
- 5. Computers, keyboards, scanners & mouse to be utilized for EHR access during patient's clinical stay. This is the norm for all patient rooms.
- 6. Whiteboards such as Promethean, can be utilized by all Faculty during Skills lab, that allows projected images from the computer while emphasizing key points to highlight which will assist in interactivity between students and their education.

I have attached quotes from the various vendors. The equipment should have a life expectancy of 5 – 10 years without any anticipated upgrades. All vendors are state approved since I currently order from these vendors for each semester student's lab supplies. The lab is under the direct supervision of myself and Faculty. Students are not left alone in the lab. Lab is kept locked during closed hours.

I utilize my budgeted allowance for undergraduate supplies which consists of all lab disposable items such as medication and IV kits for all students (including 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> level), foley kits, wound care/Central line dressing kits, vital signs, bedside patient care, otoscope/opthalmoscope, neuro checks, musculoskeletal checks, ostomy, handwashing, PPE, restraints, SCD/TED, mobility, plus other supplies to maintain stock/inventory for all of the campuses, including Shreveport, Natchitoches, Alexandria Rapides, Alexandria Airpark and Leesville.

The upgraded equipment requested is costly and would consume more than my budgeted allotments, but, these upgrades should last and can be utilized for many years.

The quotes included are from approved vendors such as Pocket Nurse, Medline, Trafera, IT support, Amazon and Dell, for review.

I will be responsible for implementing this lab upgrade plan and will utilize the Nursing Faculty for their input to ensure that these plans reflect our goals and objectives to provide our Nursing students with the supplies, equipment and knowledge needed to be successful as a Nurse providing the best patient care with the best possible patient outcomes.

**RE: Nursing Lab Upgrades** 

Good afternoon,

As the most comprehensive nursing program in the state, it is imperative that the nursing skills labs at Northwestern State be equipped with the most up-to-date equipment possible. Students rely on lab equipment to be prepared for their clinical rotations. As such, there are several initiatives that the College of Nursing and School of Allied Health would like to begin to modernize the existing labs.

First, we would like to consolidate the number of nursing beds in the Shreveport lab to simulate the hospital experience more accurately. Each lab station will need to be equipped with a hospital bed, manikin, monitor, EHR computer w/mouse/scanner, SCD machine, V/S machine, headwall w/O2, air, suction, IVAC, sharps and gloves on the wall. This will give the nursing student a visualization and realization of a real patient room so that they become familiar with the equipment and know their way around the room.

In addition to the skills lab upgrades, we would like to implement the use of smartboard technology to improve faculty teaching methods. This will provide an opportunity for faculty to share information in real time to the students on all campuses.

Finally, we want to implement virtual anatomy and virtual reality as part of the nursing education experience. By transferring the existing Anatomage table from the library to the nursing skills lab, we can ensure that more students and faculty have access to this virtual technology. Further, CONSAH has invested in virtual reality equipment that will be used to enhance the lab experience for students.

While we know that these initiatives will require some costs, we feel that it is paramount to modernize the nursing skills lab to provide the best possible outcomes for students, while also staying competitive with other nursing programs in the area.

I look forward to working with you in pursuing these upgrades.

As the department head of the nursing programs, I strive to ensure that our students are provided with up-to-date information and resources that best mimic what they will see in our area clinical agencies. Over the last few semesters, we have received concerns from students describing the discordance between what is encountered in our simulated laboratory practice and their face-to-face clinical practice. The comments center around missing common equipment that is seen in all patient rooms and include: IV poles and pumps, oxygen and suction outlets, pulse oximetry monitors, computer access to electronic medical records, mounted glove boxes, and mounted sharps containers.

We are asking for grant funding to be awarded so that these items may be purchased. and our simulated laboratory upgraded. Thank you for any consideration you can give our students.
