

NSU Associate of General Studies FACT SHEET

NEED-TO-KNOW ITEMS

- Students must complete and email a NSU DE AGS Interest Application to <u>Academic Advising Services</u> so they can formally audit students' transcripts to confirm eligibility and completion of the AGS degree.
 - Students should submit the form *in their junior year* but *no later than when registering for classes for fall of their senior year* when at all possible.
- Students will continue to follow their high school's policies when registering for courses, with help from NSU's Dual Enrollment Program staff.
- ACT scores must be sent directly to the Admissions Office.
- Official Transcripts for all non-NSU post-secondary courses must be sent directly to the Admissions Office.
- CLEP scores must be sent to the Testing Center's email address.
- Students who attend NSU ADVANCE camp must contact Mrs. Harriet Palmer to request ADVANCED credit be applied to the AGS degree.
- Any transcripts of classes taken (at another institution, CLEP, etc.) need to be submitted BEFORE the Spring semester.
- In March of a student's graduation year, Academic Advising Services will provide students with a NSU Graduation Application they must sign and return to the <u>Academic Advising Services</u> office.
- Although high school seniors will fulfill AGS degree requirements by May, degrees will not be conferred until after official confirmation of high school diploma in the summer.
- 10. Students who fail to complete the AGS degree as a dual enrollment student may complete it if they are admitted and continue as a degree seeking student at NSU.
