STUDENT ACCOUNTS

All students receive a user account name and password that enables access to all online services. The username format is derived from the following convention:

first initial + up to 13 characters of last name + last 6 digits of Campus Wide ID (CWID)

Example: vdemon456789 – Victor Demon with CWID 123456789

Usernames can be retrieved via <https://my.nsula.edu> and click on Forgot Username

Your initial password will be Demons + six-digit date of birth – Example: Demons120184

After you first log in to myNSU, please click the Password Management menu and select “Setup Password Reset”. Complete your “Security info” profile with a personal email address and mobile phone number. This action will grant you the ability to reset your password by receiving an email or text message. Students will use this form of identification to access all online services such as myNSU, Moodle, Microsoft Office 365 (email), the wireless network, computer labs, and library databases.

myNSU

This portal provides access to all personal, financial, and academic information. The portal will also offer click-through access to online services such as Moodle, Microsoft 365 (Outlook E-mail, OneDrive, Teams), and NSUConnect. <https://my.nsula.edu>

MOODLE

MICROSOFT 365

The University utilizes Microsoft 365. This service provides each student with email, file storage in OneDrive, collaboration in Teams, and access to web versions of Word, PowerPoint, Excel, and OneNote. MICROSOFT TEAMS

Microsoft Teams is a component of the Microsoft 365 Suite. Teachers can use Teams to conduct live class sessions and meetings with students for a more interactive learning environment. All students, faculty, and staff have access to Teams. The service can be used not only in your academic work but in student organizations and class projects. Microsoft provides a Teams mobile app for your smartphone or tablet to allow you to stay engaged while on the go.

WEBEX

WebEx is a tool that allows for practical online training and courses. Teachers can use WebEx to conduct live class sessions and meetings with online students for a more interactive learning environment. Northwestern State University has a WebEx address specifically for the courses and workshops offered through NSU. COMPUTER LABS

Northwestern has [computer labs](#) on each campus that are provided for students and are free to use during posted operational hours.

Student Technology labs follow the NSU academic calendar. The labs do not open on any weekend that precedes or follows a scheduled student break and does not reopen until the official date and time that classes resume.

DOCUMENTS/WEB PRINTING

Web Printing is a service to enable printing for laptop, wireless and unauthenticated users without the need to install print drivers. Students will need to be present in the lab to claim their printouts before submitting a print job. Print jobs are available during the lab's normal operating hours. File types that can be used for web printing include Microsoft Word (.doc & .docx), Microsoft Excel (.xls & .xlsx), Microsoft PowerPoint (.ppt & .pptx), Adobe Acrobat (.pdf) and Microsoft Document Writer files (.xps).
