

Information for Applicants who wish to Re-Apply to the DNP Nurse Anesthesia Program Who Applied in the Previous Year:

DNP Program:

- 1. Send an email to DNPapp@nsula.edu with the subject line: INTENT TO REAPPLY.
- 2. You are not required to reapply to NSU's Graduate School or to pay NSU's Graduate School application fee again. Upon receipt of the Intent to Reapply email, the program will contact the Graduate School and request your application be renewed for the current application cycle.
- 3. Include in the email your intent to reapply to the DNP Nurse Anesthesia program and a brief summary of relevant activities that may affect your application, such as completing additional graduate level coursework, obtaining new certifications (i.e., CCRN), or updating employment information (i.e., transferred from ER to SICU).
- 4. Include in your email, a current mailing address, e-mail, and phone number(s).

NursingCAS Portal:

Only applications from the prior year will be carried over to the current cycle.

- 1. Updated transcripts ONLY if new coursework was taken.
- 2. Updated evaluations (letters of recommendation)
- 3. Updated certifications, if applicable (CCRN, BLS, ACLS, PALS)
- 4. Updated nursing license, if applicable
- 5. Updated CV
- 6. Updated narrative essay describing the DNP degree

Information for Applicants who wish to Re-Apply to the DNP Nurse Anesthesia Program Who Applied Prior in the Previous Year

For those applicants who are re-applying to the DNP Nurse Anesthesia Program, who applied prior to the immediate previous application year, the application process will begin as if no previous application was received.

A new NSU Graduate School application including payment of the associated fee, and a new NursingCAS application is required. These re-applicants are also required to submit all new supporting documents as per the admission guidelines found in the DNP FAQ document and within the NursingCAS homepage.
