*Northwestern State University awards loans and Grants on an Academic Year Basis ending with the Summer Session. Therefore, any amounts borrowed in the Fall 2023 - Spring 2024 Semesters will affect your summer eligibility amount.

A student must be enrolled in at least half-time to be eligible for Federal Direct Loans (6 hours is considered half time status for undergraduate and 5 hours for graduate students). Students cannot borrow more than the amounts listed above for the full academic year or more than their cost of attendance.

- I understand that the disbursement for my student loan will not occur until I begin attending 6 hours undergraduate or 5 hours graduate and at that time I will have two disbursements on my loan.
- I understand that my second student loan disbursement will not occur until approximately the midpoint of my summer loan period.
- I understand that my financial aid award is based off my summer registration hours and that my award will be adjusted if my registered hours change.
- I understand that enrolled hours that are not part of my degree program will not be used when determining Title IV (grants, loans) eligibility.
- Pell grant funds will be awarded based on Full Time (12 hours) status. Pell will disburse based on actual hours attending and most students must be enrolled in at least 6 hours to receive Summer Pell disbursements.
- By signing and submitting this application any awards will be automatically accepted on your behalf. You do have the option to request a reduction if desired.
