How Do I Create a Text and Media Resource?

Text and media

The text and media resource enables text and multimedia to be inserted into the course page in between links to other resources and activities. Text and media is versatile and can help to improve the appearance of a course if used thoughtfully.

To add Text and media:


Log in to Moodle and navigate to the course.

Turn editing on.


Edit mode




Within a topic, click on the add an activity or resource.



The Add an activity or resource picker will open.






Notice the icons below Text and media. The star icon will allow instructors to "star" an activity or resource that is used most frequently.

The activity or resource picker also allows toggling between Starred, All, Activities, and Resources.

Add an activity or resource



Clicking on the "I" —information icon—will open a window that gives more information about the activity or resource.

Text and media area

The Text and media area enables you to display text and multimedia on the course page.

You can use a Text and media area to:

Split up a long list of course activities with a subheading or an image
Display an embedded video directly on the course page
Add a short description to a course section

Choose Text and media.

Moodle will open the "Adding a new Text and media area" page.

Add the Text and Media text. (If you don't add a title the system will generate one, but it doesn't show the title in your Moodle shell).

You can customize font by using the editing tools.

Text and multimedia can be inserted as well.
