The *Choose a question type to add* menu will appear. Moodle offers a wide selection of question types. The three most commonly used question types are true/false, multiple choice and essay. We will focus on these.

Adding Questions

To add a question, click on the question type.

To the right of the question types, there is a help screen that will describe the type of question chosen.

Adding a True/False Question

Make sure that you have the correct Category selected.

<u>Question name</u>—Give the question a descriptive name. This makes it easy to identify it in the question bank list. The question name is not visible to students.

<u>Question Text</u> - Enter the actual question here. Images, audio and video can also be inserted into this field using the *HTML editor toolbar*.

<u>Default Mark</u> - Can be set by entering a numerical value (i.e. the maximum number of marks for this question).

<u>General feedback</u>— Shown to the student after they have completed the question.

<u>ID Number</u>—If used, the ID number must be unique within each question category. It provides another way of identifying a question which is sometimes useful, but can usually be left blank.

Adding a Multiple choice question

<u>ID Number</u>—If used, the ID number must be unique within each question category. It provides another way of identifying a question which is sometimes useful, but can usually be left blank.

<u>One or multiple answers</u> —Do you want to have
one correct answer or more than one? Use the
drop down menu and select the number of correct
answers you want.

<u>Shuffle the choices</u>—If enabled, the order of the answers is randomly shuffled for each attempt. Tip: if you have "all of the above" or "none of the above" answers, select "No."

<u>Number the choices</u>—This allows you to decide how your answers are numbered.

<u>Show standard instructions</u>— If enabled, you can choose whether Moodle shows the instructions "Select one" or "Select one or more" before multiple choice answers.

Answers

Moodle gives the option of 5 answers. However, you can add or subtract to suit your needs.

<u>Choice 1 text box</u>—Type in an answer. Use the editing toolbar to customize your text. Images, audio and video can be added as well.

If the answer is correct, select 100% from the <u>Grade</u> drop down menu. If it is incorrect, leave the "Grade" set at None.

Feedback—Add feedback if desired.

Follow this procedure for all choices.

You must provide a correct answer or Moodle will not allow you to save your questions.

Response Options

Adding an Essay question

<u>Response format</u>—Allows you to choose what is available for the students when typing their essays. HTML editor is recommended.

<u>Required text</u>— Allows you to decide whether or not students must add text into the text editor when they do the question. If you only want them to upload a word-processed file as an essay, then you can set this to "Text input is optional."

<u>Input box size</u>—Dictates how many lines are in the text box.

<u>Minimum/Maximum word limit</u>— Set a minimum and/or maximum word count for the essay questions.

<u>Allow attachments</u>—If you want students to attach files, choose the number of files you want to allow.
