## Weighted Mean of Grades—Setting Weights

After changing the aggregation to weighted mean of grades, you will need to set the weights for the grade items and/or grade categories. You will just type in the number in the Weight column that represents the percentage that grade item or category is towards the Course Total. Just be sure the weights add up to 100, as Moodle will not inform that they do.

Note: It is okay to have grade items not inside of a category. Categories should only be used when you need to group several grade items together.

Also, you don't need to change the aggregation of a category into weighted mean of grades if everything in the category is of equal value. Leaving the aggregation of a category as Natural is perfectly fine.

Once the weights are entered, click Save.
