

NSU IRB Activity Summary, 2023-24:

- Total applications decreased 12% (compared to 2022-23), likely due to lower NSU enrollment.
- 2. Total <u>approved</u> applications remained the same, due to fewer incomplete applications.
- 3. NHSR approvals were again very common--over half of all approved apps.
- 4. Incomplete applications decreased 75%, due to better communication and follow-up with researchers.

Conclusions:

For 2024-25, we expect more use of the NHSR and Quality Improvement review systems. In addition, we will continue to work to resolve all incomplete apps.
