

## REFLECTING ON THE CAREERS OF TWO DEPARTMENT GREATS



Professor Art Dew

Professor Arthur Dew graduated from Northwestern State University with his Bachelor's degree in Speech in 1965. He went on to earn his Master's degree in 1969 while also working as a Graduate Assistant. He taught at Natchitoches High from 1969–2007, while also teaching evening COMM 1010 classes for Northwestern. In 2007 he began his teaching career at Northwestern State. His favorite courses to teach were radio and television broadcasting, his specialty.

Mr. Dew has made countless memories with the department, but some of his favorites were the eight years he spent as faculty advisor for KNWD. One student also stands out after all these years; a young lady who enrolled in his class and would attend up until it was time to give the first speech. She did this three different semesters until she absolutely needed to pass the course to graduate. Professor Dew motivated the student, and she went on to give wonderful speeches. Before she graduated, she returned to tell Mr. Dew she had decided to be a speech teacher.

It takes professionals like Mr. Dew, with a passion for education, to truly impact students. His experiences and expertise are unmatched, and he is a vital member of the NMJCA faculty. In his own words, "I love NSU, and I have to say I love my students. My family says, 'why don't you retire?' I say, 'because I've never worked a day in my life."

Dr. Ronald McBride has been associated with NSU for 40 years. His faculty career started in 1985, and he moved to the Communications department in 1996.

One of Dr. McBride's most memorable moments was in 1994 when the department, along with the science department, produced a national award-winning program, "Science, Out of This World," delivered by satellite to middle school students around the country. This won the department and University the New York Festivals Non-Broadcast Media Award for the best science class delivered via satellite in the nation. Students were able to accomplish this due to exceptional, quality instruction and state-of-the-art equipment. He also had the honor of teaching a communication class in KongJu National University in Gongju, South Korea as part of a scholar exchange program between NSU and KongJu.

Dr. McBride plays a vital role in the NMJCA department, and he has always been valued. He believes that in the future, "The potential is huge. When you have a world-class faculty, production and post-production facilities and equipment, a state-of-the-art multi-purpose television studio and production facility, the program can accomplish anything it desires."
