Your FAFSA application was selected for review by the U.S. Dept. of Education for a process called verification. In this process NSU must compare information from your FAFSA with the documentation supplied to our office. We must collect all information before you can be awarded any type of Title IV aid. **If there are differences between your FAFSA and the other documents you supply, additional information may be requested and corrections may need to be submitted.** Your financial aid **will not** be processed until this form has been completed, returned, and verified.

1. Complete all sections and sign the worksheet - you and your parents must sign the worksheet.
2. Submit all required documents to the Office of Student Financial Aid. Student may visit their MY NSU my.nsula.edu to view all required documents. All required documents must be received on or prior to the last day of the semester by which you are attending.
3. If you and/or parents did not use the IRS Tax Retrieval process or you made changes after the IRS Retrieval, contact the IRS at www.irs.gov or call 1-800-908-9946 to obtain a 2023 tax transcript.
4. If you, the student did not file and/or is not required to file an IRS 1040, you must affirm that you are not required to file an IRS 1040 and include a copy of all 2023 W2 Forms from all employers, if applicable.
