- 2. Submit <u>all</u> required documents to the Office of Financial Aid. Student may visit their MY NSU <u>my.nsula.edu</u> to view all required documents. <u>All</u> required documents must be received on or prior to the last day of the semester by which you are attending.
- 3. If you, the student or spouse (if married) did not use the IRS Tax Retrieval process or you made changes after the IRS Retrieval, contact the IRS at www.irs.gov or call 1-800-908-9946 to obtain a 2023 tax transcript.
- 4. If you, the student or spouse (if married) did not file and/or is not required to file an IRS 1040, you must affirm that you are not required to file an IRS 1040 and include a copy of all 2023 W2 Forms from all employers, if applicable.
