Students must meet all eligibility criteria listed below to receive the Hardship Waiver. If approved, the waiver will be posted on your student account to off-set the tuition increase.

### Criteria for Financial Hardship Waiver

- Louisiana resident
- Full-time enrollment status (12 or more hours)
- Must apply for, and be deemed eligible to receive, Federal Financial Aid
- Must qualify and receive Pell Grant disbursement
- The waiver cannot be used in connection with other scholarships that exempt the same fees
- The amount of the waiver will be no more than the \$300 per semester
