ESTIMATED CLINICAL OBLIGATIONS and EXPENSES

BSRS clinical students at Northwestern State University have a number of clinical obligations and expenses. The obligations and fees include, but are not limited to, the following:

Clinical Obligations*:

- Health form - varies according to the facility and the student
- Drug screening - varies according to the facility
- Background investigations ~\$40
- iPads~\$525 (if purchased in bookstore)
- Travel to clinical sites varies. Students will be scheduled at clinical sites within a 65-mile radius of their designated campus: either Shreveport or Alexandria, La.
- Various clinical rotation times/shifts throughout the program:
 - 4:30 am to 1:00 pm
 - 5:00 am to 1:30 pm
 - 6:45 am to 3:15 pm
 - 7:00 am to 3:30 pm
 - 8:00 am to 4:30 pm
 - 8:30 am to 4:30 pm
 - 10:30 am to 7:00 pm
 - 12:00 pm to 8:30 pm
 - 3:00 pm to 11:30 pm
- Parking fees at clinical sites
- Trajecsyst-\$150 total

 - All students taking Internet courses will be assessed a \$50/course Electronic Learning Fee

Additional fees*:

- Lab fees – \$150 for 3 courses (\$50 per course)
- Professional degree fees-\$300 for 5 semesters
- Uniforms ~\$75 for set of scrubs
- Books~varies per semester
- CPR~\$40 for class, ~\$20 for book, ~\$15 mask
- Immunization updates annually, fees vary (ex. Flu shots, TB screening)
- If applicable, medical expenses related to MRI screening (ex., Imaging of orbits in cases of prior eye injuries involving metallic objects or fragments)
- RadTech Bootcamp~\$150
- Lead Markers ~\$35
- Registry preparation materials ~\$600
- Graduation fees ~\$75
- Recognition pin ~\$55
- ARRT certification exam ~\$250
- LSRTBE license ~\$110

Any costs pertaining to these obligations are the responsibility of the student.
