

## **Master of Education in Curriculum and Instruction with a concentration in Academic Content (504K)**

The Master of Education (M.Ed.) program in Curriculum and Instruction with a concentration in Academic Content is designed for content teachers. This program enhances their instructional expertise along with graduate content coursework.

Prerequisites for this program include a valid teaching license as well as admission to the graduate school.

**Degree requirements for this program and concentration include 12 hours of foundation coursework; 9 hours of support and application coursework; and 15 hours of concentration coursework.**
