****Students may be eligible to complete fewer than 900 field practicum hours if approved for advanced standing OR when graduating from a CSWE accredited BSW program and meeting minimum GPA (3.0) and course waiver requirements. The following courses are eligible to be waived: SOWK 5600 and SOWK 5620.**
