ARE YOU AWARE THAT SEXUAL VIOLENCE AGAINST MEN HAPPENS ON COLLEGE CAMPUSES?

- * **Male college-aged students (18-24) are 5 times more likely than non-students the same age to be a victim of rape or sexual assault.**
- * **1 out of every 10 rape victims are male.**
- * **2.78 million men in the U.S. had been victims of attempted or completed rape as of 1998.**
- * **6.8% of male undergraduates have experienced non-consensual sexual contact since enrolling.**
