

School Librarian

(add-on)

An authorization to serve as school librarian will be added to the certificate for teaching in the elementary or secondary school for those teachers who have completed a minimum of 18 semester hours in library science (LDOE)

Coursework may be taken through NSU at the undergraduate or graduate level. At the graduate level, students may choose to pursue an M.Ed. in Curriculum and Instruction with a concentration in Library Science. Twelve of the 18 hours in this certification may be used toward the M.Ed. degree.
