MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN NORTHWESTERN STATE UNIVERSITY OF LOUISIANA AND **DELGADO COMMUNITY COLLEGE**

Northwestern State University of Louisiana (NSULA) and Delgado Community College (DCC) have agreed to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding for an articulation program between the two institutions. The articulation program will allow graduates of DCC Associate of Applied Science in Respiratory Care Technology program to complete the first two years of study at DCC and transfer all credit hours as designated in Appendix A to NSULA for completion of the Bachelors of Applied Science in Allied Health (BASAH). Students transferring to NSULA may complete the last two years of their course work at NSULA. Both institutions serve constituency needs and are responsive, student oriented institutions that prepare the students to become productive members of society as well as promote the academic development and improvement in the quality of life of citizens in their regions.

This partnership is mutually beneficial to both institutions for several reasons:

- DCC traditional and non-traditional students will have the opportunity after completing the Applied Science in Respiratory Care Technology degree at DCC to transfer to the BASAH program that will accept DCC credits.
- NSULA will have the opportunity to accept students into the BASAH Program who are well prepared with the foundational course work.
- Both NSULA and DCC are accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC).
- Both NSULA and DCC have full-time faculty with advanced academic and professional credentials and both have support resources (i.e. library, Internet access, and adequate administrative-faculty-staff support).

In accordance with this Memorandum of Understanding, DCC agrees to:

- Provide academic advising to respiratory care technology students who plan to transfer to NSULA according to agreements in Appendix A.
- Provide students the opportunity to obtain the DCC credit hours as listed in Appendix A of the Memorandum of Understanding between NSULA and DCC.
- Provide information about the articulation Agreement in the DCC General Catalog.
- Jointly market the articulation agreement with NSULA

In accordance with this Memorandum of Understanding, Northwestern State University of Louisiana agrees to:

• Receive and maintain Intent to Transfer forms from DCC students and honor the agreement regarding academic catalog in effect on the date of the student's signature and the NSULA confirmation signature. (Appendix B).

- Accept DCC credit hours as listed in Appendix A of the Memorandum of Understanding between NSULA and DCC.
- Provide DCC with copies of the NSULA Application for Admission into the Bachelor of Applied Science in Allied Health and other advising materials.
- Provide information about the articulation Agreement in the Northwestern State University of Louisiana catalog.
- Jointly market the articulation agreement with DCC.

By signature of Dr. James B. Henderson, President Northwestern State University of Louisiana and signature of Joan Y. Davis, Chancellor Delgado Community College, this articulation Memorandum of Understanding is entered into on the April' 2016.

This agreement may be revised only with the signatures of the leaders of both institutions.
