#### Academic Calendar Committee Meeting Minutes Henderson Conference Room, Caspari Hall March 14, 2018

The Academic Calendar Committee was called to order at 2:03 p.m. on March 14, 2018, in the Henderson Conference Room, Caspari Hall.

The purpose of this meeting was to evaluate academic calendars for spring, summer, and fall 2019 semesters to ensure that all classes meet the minimum meeting requirements; review proposed academic calendar options; ensure that all future calendars for the next five years meet the minimum requirements according to Board's policy; and develop a policy for making up missed contact hours due to natural disaster.

According to the Board of Supervisors for the University of Louisiana System, three-hour classes must meet 2250 minutes; two-hour classes must meet 1500 minutes; and one-hour classes must meet 750 minutes.

1. The Academic Calendar Committee thoroughly reviewed and discussed the following academic calendar options for the spring, summer, and fall 2019 semesters:

Includes an 11-week summer session- (A week between the spring/summer and summer/fall) Option 1A

Includes a 12-week summer session - (A week between spring/summer and no break Option 1B between summer/fall)

Includes a 12-week summer session - (A week between spring/Summer and a week between Option 1C summer/fall). Note: This option does not meet the minimum meeting requirements.

Includes a 12-week summer session - (A week between spring/summer and a week between Option 2A summer/fall. Note: This option does not meet the minimum meeting requirements.

Includes a 12-week summer session - (No break between spring/summer and a week Option 2B between summer/fall). Note: This option does not meet the minimum meeting requirements.

2. After thoroughly discussing the above options, the Academic Calendar Committee members approved and adopted Option 1B as revised without opposition. Option 1B was revised to include an earlier spring break as indicated below:
