



MEMORANDUM OF
UNDERSTANDING

SUSLA

BETWEEN

Northwestern State University

AND

Southern University at Shreveport

Northwestern State University of Louisiana (NSU) and Southern University at Shreveport (SUSLA) have agreed to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding for an articulation program between the two institutions. The articulation program will allow students to complete the Radiologic Technology Associate of Applied Science program at SUSLA and transfer all credit hours as designated in Appendix A to NSU for completion of the Bachelor of Science in Radiologic Sciences (BSRS) degree. Students transferring to NSU may complete the last two years of their course work at NSU. Both institutions serve constituency needs and are responsive, student oriented institutions that prepare the students to become productive members of society as well as promote the academic development and improvement in the quality of life of citizens in their regions.

This partnership is mutually beneficial to both institutions for several reasons. Traditional and non-traditional students attending SUSLA will have the opportunity after earning Radiologic Technology Associate of Applied Science at SUSLA to transfer to a BSRS program that will accept SUSLA credits. NSU will have the opportunity to accept students into the BSRS who are well prepared with foundation course work.

Both the University and the College are accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.

Both the University and the College have full-time faculty with advanced academic and professional credentials and both have support resources (i.e., library, on-line access, service courses, and adequate administrative-faculty-staff backup).

In accordance with this Memorandum of Understanding, Southern University at Shreveport agrees to:


- Provide academic advising to students who plan to transfer to NSU according to agreements in Appendix A.
- Have SUSLA students who intend to transfer to NSU sign the Intent to transfer form and mail the completed form to NSU. (Appendix B)
- Provide students the opportunity to obtain the SUSLA credit hours as listed in Appendix A of the Memorandum of Understanding between NSU and SUSLA.
- Provide transferring students assistance in completing a NSU BSRS Application for Admission into the BSRS program.
- Provide information about the Articulation Agreement in the Southern University at Shreveport General Catalog.
- Jointly market the articulation agreement with NSU.

In accordance with this Memorandum of Understanding, Northwestern State University agrees to:

- Receive and maintain "Intent to Transfer" forms from SUSLA students and honor the agreement regarding academic catalog in effect on the date of the student's signature and the NSU confirmation signature. (Appendix B).
- Accept Southern University at Shreveport credit hours as listed in Appendix A of the Memorandum of Understanding between Northwestern State University and SUSLA.
- Provide SUSLA with copies of the Application for Admission into the BSRS program and other advising materials.
- Provide information about the Articulation Agreement in the Northwestern State University catalog.
- Jointly market the articulation agreement with SUSLA.

By signature of President Randall J. Webb, Northwestern State University and signature of Chancellor Ray L. Benton, Southern University at Shreveport, this Articulation Memorandum of Understanding is entered into on the 8th of March, 2012.




