

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
BETWEEN  
NORTHWESTERN STATE UNIVERSITY OF LOUISIANA  
AND  
LOUISIANA DELTA COMMUNITY COLLEGE**

Northwestern State University of Louisiana (NSULA) and Louisiana Delta Community College (LDCC) have agreed to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding for a 2 + 2 program between the two institutions. The 2 + 2 program will allow students in LDCC Associate of Science in Nursing (ASN) program to complete the first two years of study at LDCC and transfer all credit hours as designated in Appendix A to NSULA for completion of the Bachelors of Science in Nursing (BSN). Students transferring to NSULA may complete the last two years of their course work at NSULA. Both institutions serve constituency needs and are responsive, student oriented institutions that prepare the students to become productive members of society as well as promote the academic development and improvement in the quality of life of citizens in their regions.

This partnership is mutually beneficial to both institutions for several reasons:

- LDCC traditional and non-traditional students will have the opportunity after completing core requirements at LDCC to transfer to an accredited BSN program that will accept Delta credits.
- NSULA will have the opportunity to accept students into the BSN Program who are well prepared with the foundational course work.
- Both NSULA and LDCC are accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on College (SACSCOC)
- Both NSULA and LDCC have full-time faculty with advanced academic and professional credentials and both have support resources (i.e. library, Internet access, and adequate administrative-faculty-staff support).

In accordance with this Memorandum of Understanding, LDCC agrees to:


- Provide academic advising to ASN students who plan to transfer to NSULA according to agreements in Appendix A.
- Have LDCC ASN students who intend to transfer to NSULA sign the Intent to Transfer Form and email the completed form (Appendix B) to NSULA: RN-BSN Program Director, 1800 Line Ave, Shreveport, LA 71101.  
Delta Community College will make available a list of graduates and their mailing address upon request in an effort to avail and encourage graduates to further their education at a 4-year institution.
- Provide students the opportunity to obtain the LDCC credit hours as listed in Appendix A of the Memorandum of Understanding between NSULA and LDCC.
- Provide transferring ASN students assistance in completing the NSULA Application for Admission into the BSN Program.
- Provide information about the 2 + 2 Agreement in the LDCC General Catalog.
- Jointly market the 2 + 2 agreement with NSULA


In accordance with this Memorandum of Understanding, Northwestern State University of Louisiana agrees to:

- Receive and maintain Intent to Transfer forms from LDCC students and honor the agreement regarding academic catalog in effect on the date of the student's signature and the NSULA confirmation signature. (Appendix B).
- Accept Delta credit hours as listed in Appendix A of the Memorandum of Understanding between NSULA and LDCC.
- Provide LDCC with copies of the NSULA Application for Admission into the Bachelor of Science in Nursing and other advising materials.
- Provide information about the 2 + 2 Agreement in the Northwestern State University of Louisiana website.
- Jointly market the 2 + 2 agreement with LDCC.
