CHEMISTRY LAB SAFETY RULES

- 1. Safety glasses must be worn at all times in the lab. Contacts should not be worn in the lab.
- 2. Know the location of the eye wash station, safety shower, and fire extinguisher.
- 3. Report all injuries to the instructor immediately.
- 4. Read and reread the labels on chemical containers before using.
- 5. Use the fume hood whenever irritating or poisonous fumes are involved.
- 6. Remember that relatively harmless chemicals, if improperly mixed or handled, may be extremely dangerous.
- 7. Report all spills to the instructor immediately.
- 8. Keep your lab bench neat, clean and dry.
- 9. Never spray other students with any liquids including water.
- 10. Never look into the opening of any chemical container.
- 11. Never bring chemical containers near your face.
- 12. Never bring chemicals into contact with the eyes, nose, mouth, skin, or clothing.
- 13. Never eat or drink in the laboratory.
- 14. Never leave an experiment unattended.
- 15. Never attempt an experiment that is not a part of the class. The instructor must approve all experiments.
- 16. Never pour or handle flammable substances near an open flame.
- 17. Never add water to concentrated acids.
- 18. Never return unused reagents to stock bottles. Take only what you need.
- 19. Never work in the laboratory without the instructor's permission.
- 20.Instructor's permission is required to have visitors in the lab.
