LAB SAFETY RULES

- 1. Food and drink are never allowed in the laboratory.
- 2. Smoking is forbidden inside the building, therefore the laboratory.
- 3. Maintain your work area as clutter-free as possible.
- 4. Personal articles should be placed so that they are safe from contamination.
- 5. Properly dispose of all waste materials. See instructor if any questions.
- 6. Notify instructor of all spills, chemical or biological, in the laboratory.
- 7. In case of a fire, notify instructor and students. Evacuate the laboratory area and sound the fire alarm.
- 8. Always wash your hands before leaving the laboratory.
- 9. Do not come to the lab alone.
- 10. Maintain a clean work area, ensuring that the area has been properly cleaned before leaving the laboratory.
- 11. The sinks are for laboratory experiments, waste and washing of equipment and hands, not trash. Please dispose of trash in the trash cans around the room.
- 12. Biohazardous waste, anything that contains bodily fluids or microbiological/biological waste must be placed in a biohazard waste bag.
- 13. Broken glassware is to be disposed of in the proper fiber containers marked glass only. This glass cannot be biologically contaminated.
