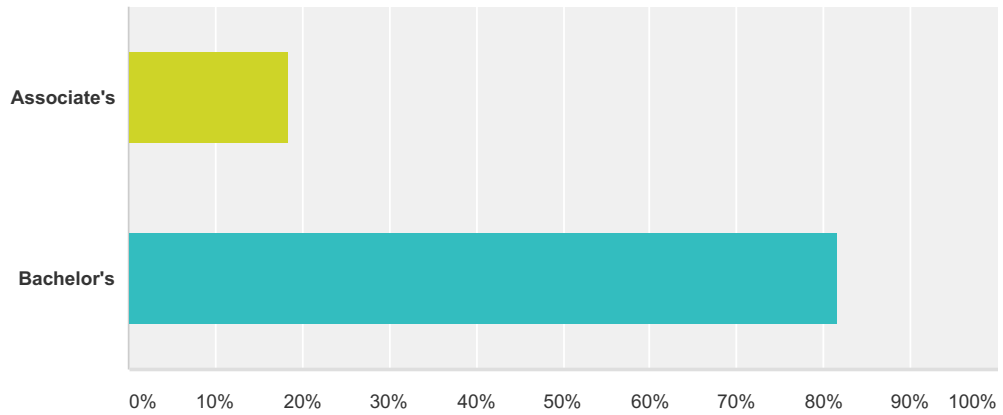

Q2 Indicate Degree Earned

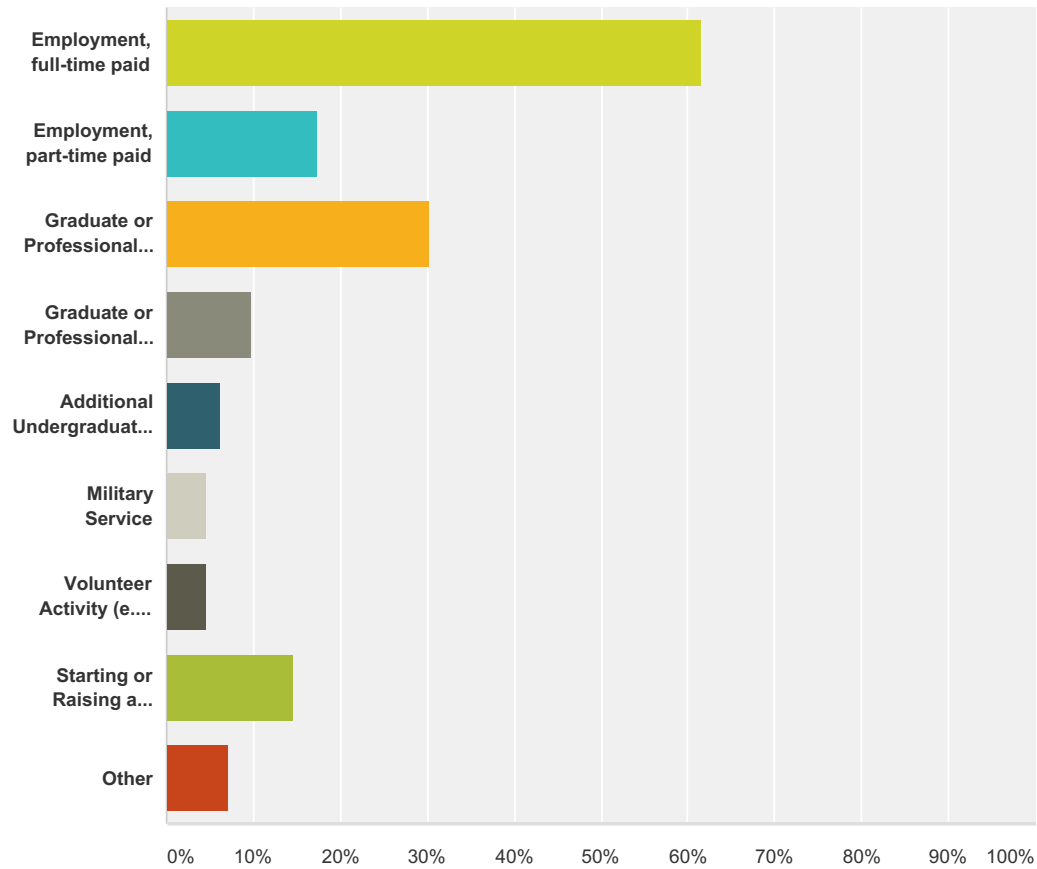

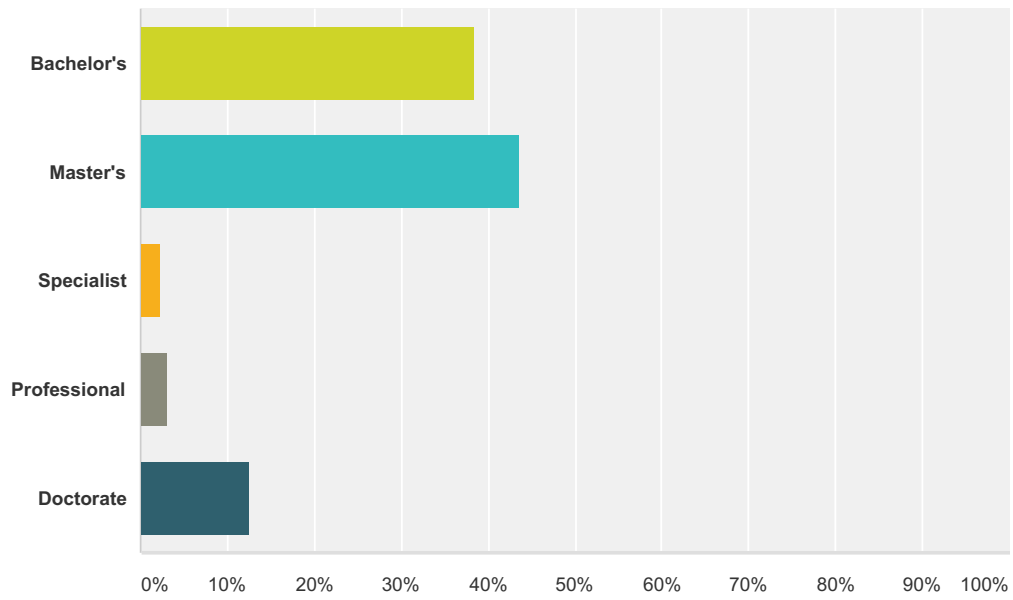

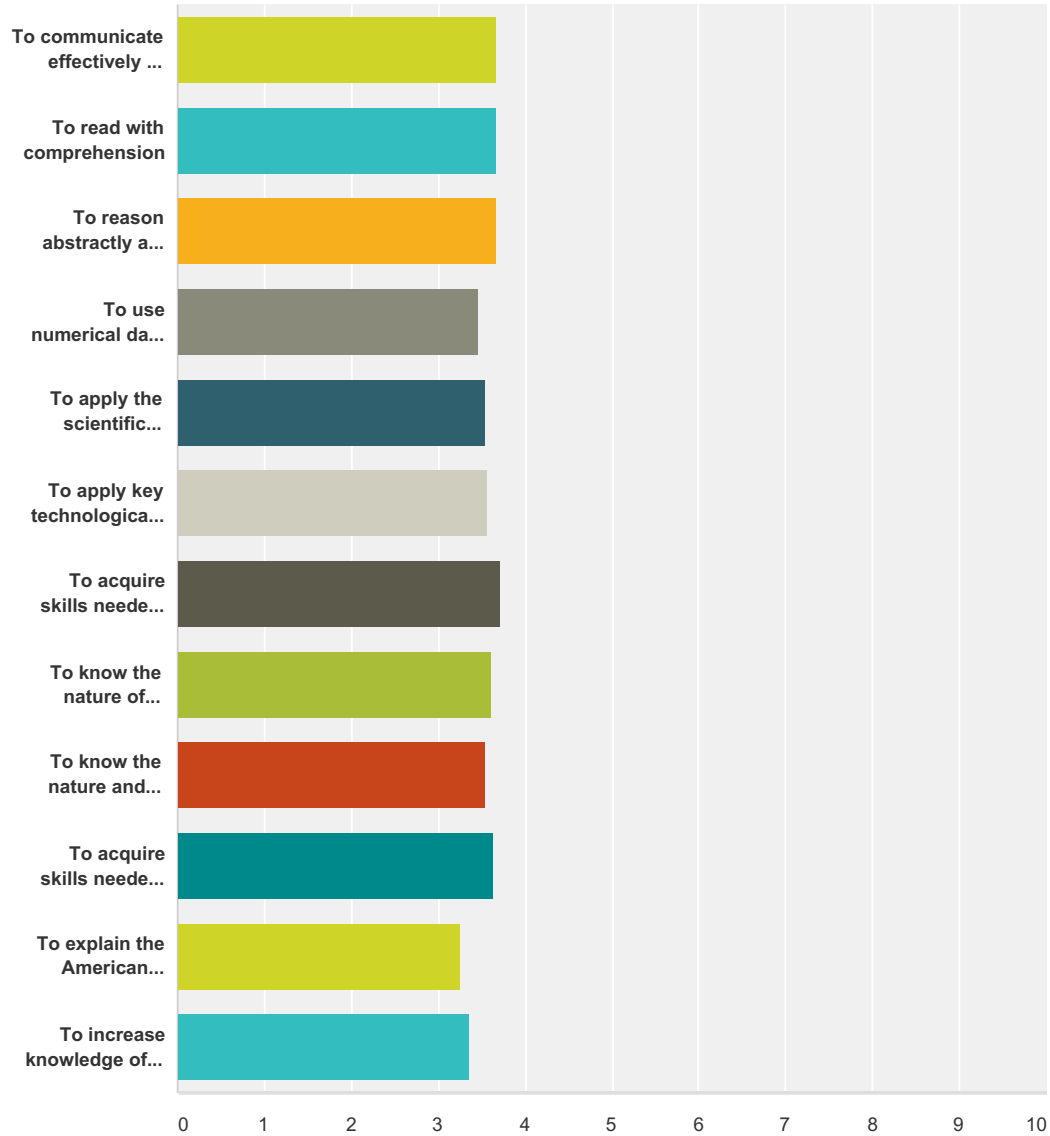

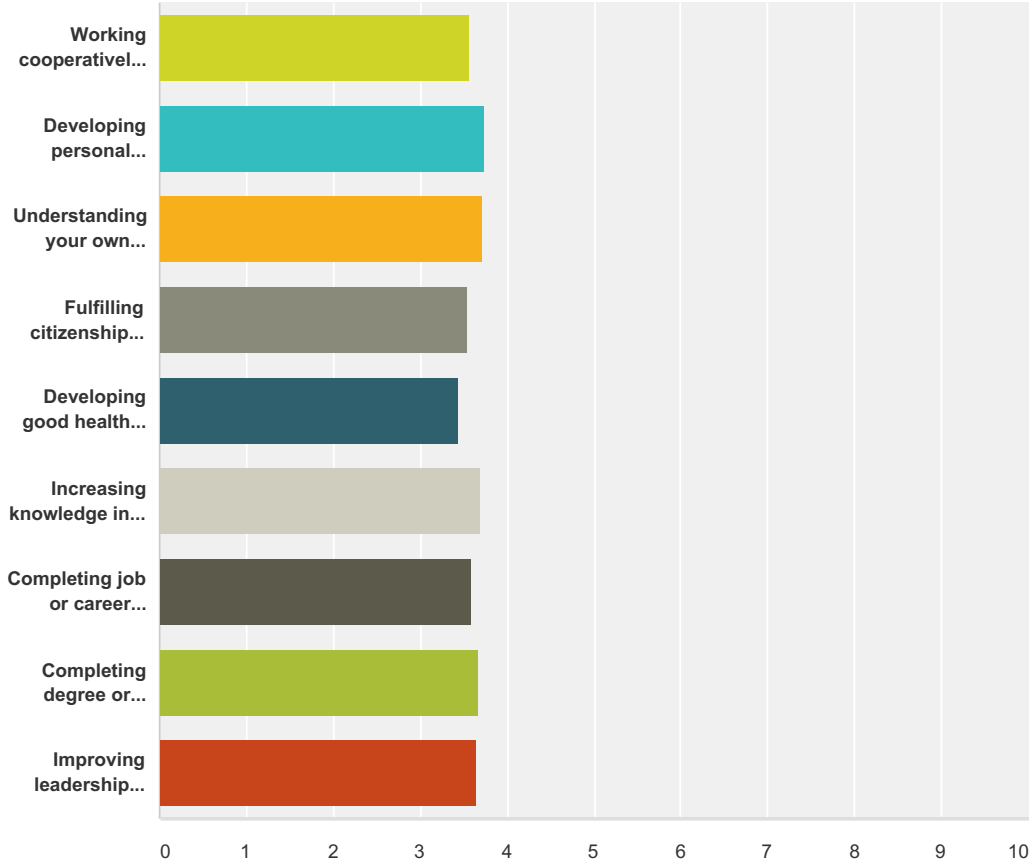

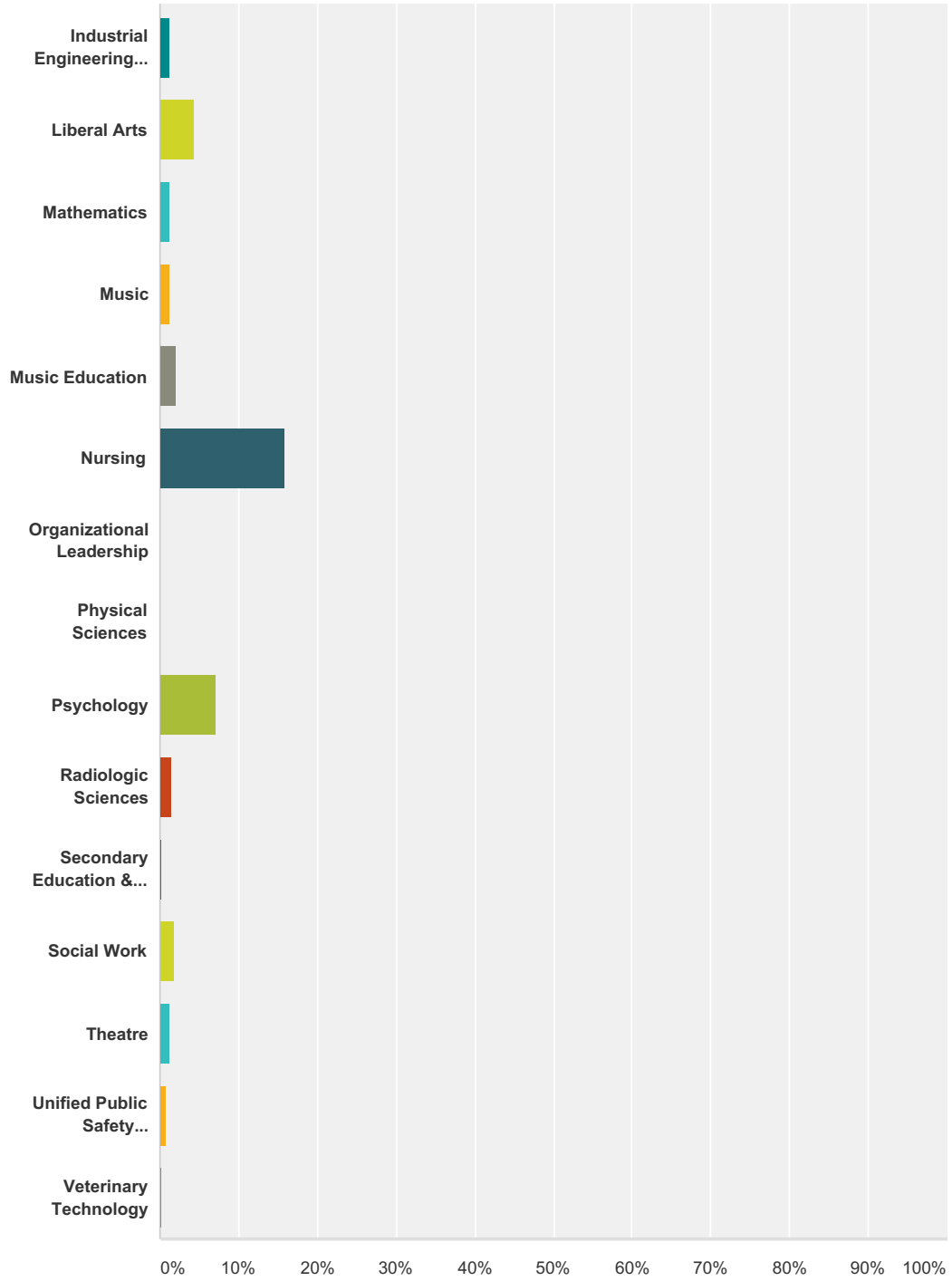
