

## APPLICATION TO ENROLL IN A COMMUNITY / JUNIOR COLLEGE WHILE UNDER ACADEMIC SUSPENSION

Pursuant to the Board of Supervisors Academic Suspension Policy, an undergraduate student suspended from a System university may not enroll in another university within the System, but <u>may enroll</u> in a community college. To ensure minimal or no loss of credits upon return to the university, it is recommended that the student consult with his/her university advisor regarding the choice of courses to be taken at the community college. Credits earned under these conditions may be accepted for a degree at the suspending institution provided grades of "C" or higher are earned in each of the courses to be transferred.

Procedure for applying to enroll in a Community/Junior College while under academic suspension from Northwestern State University

- 1) The student needs to complete and submit the application to enroll in a community/junior college while under academic suspension at Northwestern State University to the University Registrar's Office.
- 2) The University Registrar will sign and place the school seal on the application.
- 3) The application will be given to the student.
- 4) The student is responsible for taking the application to the appropriate official of the community/junior college where he/she plans to enroll, and obtain signature of authorization and the school seal.
- 5) The student must return the application (with the appropriate approving signatures and school seals) to Northwestern State University Registrar's Office, Natchitoches, La. 71497.
