McWhorter's School of Pharmacy admits 120 students, approximately 50% from out-of-state, from 1,000 - 1,200 applications received each year.

To be considered for admission to the Doctor of Pharmacy program, you must have:

- Completed between **64** and **67** college semester hours
- Completed 28 semester hours of basic science
- Completed all course prerequisites (includes Calculus I, Elementary Statistics, Physical Education Activity or Lifetime Health and Wellness/Fitness, Psychology or Sociology, Additional Liberal Arts, Human Anatomy & Physiology, Microbiology, General Chemistry, Organic Chemistry, Public Speaking, English Composition, Literature, and World History/Western Civilization or U.S./American History).
- The applicant must have completed or currently be enrolled in Organic Chemistry 1 during the fall semester to be eligible to be interviewed.

With the understanding that an applicant must have a GPA of at least 2.0 overall and in the Math/Science prerequisites to be considered, the applicant can be invited for an interview if any one of the following three criteria is met:

- 1. Overall GPA greater than or equal to 2.75 and McWhorter School of Pharmacy Math/Science Pre-requisite GPA greater than or equal to 2.75.
- 2. PCAT composite score greater than or equal to the 60th percentile.
- 3. GPA of most recent 30 credit hours greater than or equal to 3.20.

The average GPA for an admitted student is typically around 3.50.

## **Test Scores:**

A copy of your ACT or SAT must be sent directly to the MSOP Office of Admission

The requirement for the ACT/SAT is waived for any applicant who has earned a prior B.S. or B.A. degree, is over 30 years of age, or if English is the applicant's second language and that applicant did not attend High School in the U.S.

PCAT composite score: There is no *required* minimum score. However, scores above the 70th percentile rank are viewed favorably and scores below the 40th percentile rank are viewed negatively.

Letters of Recommendation (submitted via PharmCAS):

One academic letter of recommendation is required and must be completed by a college level Math or Science Professor who has taught you in class plus one non-academic letter of recommendation is also required. It is preferred that this letter be completed by a pharmacist who has supervised you in a work setting. If you do not have pharmacy experience, then the non-academic letter of recommendation may be completed by anyone who has recently supervised you in a work setting.
