Critical Course pathway ENGL 1010, MATH 1020 -> ACCT 2000; ENGL1020-->BUAD 2200; Math 1020 --> Acct 2000 --> Acct 2010 --> Fin 3090 --> Mgt 4300

Other critical paths:

Econ 2010 --> Mktg 3230 --> Mgt 4300; Math 1020 → Math 1060 → Buad 2120 and Mgt 3220 --> Mgt 3580 --> Mgt 4300 Management 4300 must be taken during your senior year (after you have 90 hours of coursework).

Many students have to repeat quantitatively oriented courses, such as Accounting or Finance, so students should begin taking courses along this path as soon as possible, and not put it off until later. **NOTE: BUAD 4900 MUST be taken during the semester that you are scheduled to graduate.**
