Overview: To install Sympodium monitors with computers, in 5 rooms on the Leesville/Fort Polk Campus. To install TI-SmartView Emulator software in 1 of these rooms. Full or partial funding is requested.
Current Population: Total Students, 507 per year with 60% activity duty military and families, 30% civilians, and 10% dual enrollment high school students.
Future Population Potential to reach 1589 students daily from the computers and Sympodium monitors (227 seats with 7 classes per day) The TI-SmartView Emulator could impact up to 322 students daily.
Student Benefits/Improving Service to Students. This equipment will engage the students by affording them opportunities to manipulate content, display information from multiple perspectives, and make choices when faculty is covering material in class. Also, the TI-SmartView Emulator will provide students with a split screen view of material being presented in a mathematics class by being able to view a graph, table, and its corresponding raw data all at the the same time (see image).
Negative Aspects if Not Funded There would be a disconnect for students between classroom instruction and independent learning activities Students would not be able to learn about the technology used outside the classroom to complete homework assignments, labs, exam, projects, and discussion boards.
