The target audience is all military science students, freshmen through senior, actively participating in scheduled military science classes and laboratories.		
2. Describe project/initiative for which you are requesting funds. (1	0 points)	
Students will use the digital camera to capture and document their training, providing a valuable resource for junior cadets to learn from before they attend the National Advanced Leadership Camp during the summer before their senior year. The camera will be used to capture training events such as Field Training Exercises, Viking Quest, as well as the annual Ranger Challenge Competition, and award and commissioning ceremonies, the Military Ball, and other public affairs activities which can be placed in newspapers and web pages.		
3. State measurable objectives that will be used to determine the im (10 points)	apact/effectiveness of the project.	
Measurable objective to be used to determine the impact/effectiveness of the digital camera will be conducted during weekly classes. The degree of proficiency and each cadet's progress will be noted by the instructors and how well they do will be integrated into the final grades for each class/laboratory.

5. Provide a justification for funding of the project. Estimate the number of students that will be served per academic year and in what ways. Please indicate also any unique needs of the target group. (10 points)

The purchase of a digital camera will enhance each cadet's skills in learning military science skills, and will also improve the quality of cadet briefings and presentations such as PowerPoint presentations enhanced with digital imagery from training exercises.

6. How will funding of the project advance the University and College / unit technology plan? Which NSTEP objective/s will this funding benefit? (15 points)

Funding of this project will benefit the unit technology plan directly. The digital camera is a state of the art technology and will be available for use by all the military science students in the course of their studies at Northwestern State University. The project will directly benefit each and every student by allowing them to learn how to use a digital camera and how to capture meaningful images of training events for incorporation into presentations and briefings. Many students have limited knowledge of the technological advancements available for their use. By incorporating these new technologies into their courses of study they will be better prepared and more competitive in today's marketplace upon searching for employment after graduation. Those who choose to make a commitment to the Army will be able to use the technologies readily available throughout the military to perform the work expected of them upon commissioning as an officer.

The individuals who will be responsible for the implementation of the project are all instructors of military science classes and laboratories. LTC Galgano, MAJ Eisenmann, and SFC Lear, each of whom are fully qualified to accomplish the objectives of the project.

Life expectancy of this camera is estimated to be five years. No anticipated equipment/software upgrades are projected.





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
