2. Describe project/initiative for which you are requesting funds.
The Department of Chemistry and Physics is requesting an upgrade of the Physics lab in Fournet Hall. This upgrade will include twenty (20) new computers with added software and a new printer. The added software is listed below:

1. Procurement Phase – The Student Technology department will collect final pricing bids from vendors.
2. Installation Phase – This phase of the project will begin as soon as the new equipment arrives. The

office of Student Technology and Information Systems will be able to install the new computers. The

major milestone of this project will be the installation of the equipment.

- 3. Utilization and Evaluation Phase: After the new computers are installed the science students will begin to utilize them immediately.



Customer's order and purchase of the Products and Services shall constitute acceptance of these terms and conditions.

1. TITLE. Title to the Products shall pass at NI's plant. NI retains a security interest and right of possession in the Products until Customer makes full payment.

TAXES. Product prices are exclusive of, and Customer shall pay, applicable sales, use, service, value added or like taxes, unless Customer has provided NI with an appropriate exemption certificate for the delivery destination acceptable to the applicable taxing authorities.

3. PRICES AND PAYMENT. All quotations shall expire thirty (30) days from date of issuance, unless otherwise set forth on the quotation or agreed in writing. Customer shall make payment in full prior to or upon delivery by cashier's check, credit card, or money order, unless NI approves Customer for credit terms. If NI approves Customer's credit application, payment shall be due no later than 30 days from the date of NI's invoice.
