1. Describe target audience.

The target audience for this grant will be the 150 students attending the Louisiana Scholars' College, as well as any NSU student who wishes to come to Morrison Hall to use the equipment.

2. Describe project/initiative for which you are requesting funds.

We will use the funds to purchase 30 computers, with 30 copies of Microsoft Office, 1 printer, 1 scanner, 1 copy of Photo Shop, 5 copies of Adobe Illustrator, and 5 copies of Macromedia FreeHandMX.

3. State measurable objectives that will be used to determine the impact/effectiveness of the project.

Our major objective is to provide our students with a site at which they can write essays, construct projects, and fulfill assignments, as well as meet for our course SCSC 1810 (Microcomputer Applications), required for all students. Many of our students do not have their own word processors, and some who do have no printers. Our curriculum requires a great number of written assignments and our current facility is in use much of the academic day. We will be able to determine how our objective is being met through the number of students who successfully complete SCSC 1810 and through the amount of paper used in the printer.

4. Indicate how each project objective will be evaluated.

We will evaluate the project by the success rate of students enrolled in SCSC 1810. We will maintain a count of the amount of paper used in the lab.

5. Provide a justification for funding of the project. Estimate the number of students that will be served per academic year and in what ways. Please indicate also any unique needs of the target group.

The SCSC 1810 course is required for each LSC student and requires a lab setting. Additionally, LSC students are required to do extensive writing in many of their classes and major class projects in others. Additionally, the software included in the grant will allow students to do design work, generate graphs and charts, and create other non-narrative kinds of projects. Most LSC students spend a part of every day in Morrison Hall and many do their homework here between classes. Having a site at which students can work during the day and into the evening is valuable for students who do not own laptops or word processors. Additionally, each of our graduating seniors writes an honors' thesis, which must be printed and bound. Our site will enable our 150 students plus any other NSU students who choose to do their work here.

6. If funded, which NSTEP (<http://www.nsula.edu/nstep/NSTEP.pdf>) objective(s) will this funding of this project advance. How will funding of the project advance the University and College / unit technology plan?

Objective 1, to improve access to technology for students and others.

Objective 3, to upgrade student technology labs

Davina McClain, director of the LSC, will be responsible for the implementation of the project. She has experience in implementing projects and seeing them through to completion from her years of experience as a department chair and director of LSC>

No personnel beyond the university technical support already in place will be required for this project.

9. Provide a schedule for implementation and evaluation.

We aim to have the computers up and running by the middle of fall semester, 2007. We will complete the evaluation of the project at the end of the 2007-2008 academic year.

10. Estimate the expected life of hardware and software. Explain any anticipated equipment/software upgrades during the next five years.

We expect the hardware will last three years. System upgrades that come with the program will happen as they are sent out.

11. Explain in detail a plan and policy that will be in place to ensure property security/controls for any equipment received through Student Tech Fee.

The lab is locked when no staff or faculty member is in the building.
