1. Describe target audience.

All students enrolled on the NSU Lecsville/Fort Polk campus and students living in this area who need to have the online test proctored at Leesville.

NSU Leesville/Fort Polk averages around 450 students during the Fall and the Spring semesters and about 200 during the Summer semester. Approximately 60-70% of the students are civilian, 20-30% are military family members, and 10% are active duty military.

2. Describe project/initiative for which you are requesting funds.

Purchase 25 computers and 6 dry erase boards.

3. State measurable objectives that will be used to determine the impact/effectiveness of the project.

Students will use the computers located in rooms 111 and 105 for testing (Proctored online test and the COMPASS test for placement).

Students will use the computers in all other classrooms for presentations and to view materials and instructional DVDs.

Students will use the dry erase boards located in classrooms for class presentations. Replacing chalkboards with dry erase boards help protect the computer equipment and also gives the PC's longer life expectancy.

4. Indicate how each project objective will be evaluated.

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NSU Lessville/Fort Polk Technology Committee will review usage of classrooms and records of proctored testing.

5. If funded, which NSTEP <u>http://www.nsula.edu/nstep/NSTEP.pdf</u> objective(s) will this funding of this project advance. How will funding of the project advance the University and College/unit technology plan?

NSTEPS Objectives 1. To improve access to technology by students, faculty, and staff at NSU. NSTEPS Objectives 2. To improve classrooms with updated technology and multimedia.

6. Provide a justification for funding of this project. Estimate the number of student that will be served per academic year and in what ways. Please indicate also any unique needs of the target group.

COMPASS Testing is done throughout each semester for students wishing to improve their placement in Math and English. Approximately 5 students/week for a total of 250 students/year

Proctored Testing is done throughout each semester for students who have missed exams or for NSU online courses. Approximately 455 + students are tested on the NSU Leesville campus.

Room 21 is the Nursing Lab. There are 20 students in clinical rotation each semester who will be using the 6 computers requested for this room and approximately 30 students in NURA 1050 will also have access to Nursing materials located on these computer. These computers house the special computer programs required for the nursing students.

The other 9 computer requested will be located in the Smart Classrooms and Compressed Video rooms on the Leesville campus for any student enrolled in a course being taught in those classrooms. These courses include but are not limited to the following areas: English, Math, Science, Spanish, History, Speech, Criminal Justice, Fine Arts, Health, Orientation, Psychology, Social Work, Education, Nursing, Business, etc.

7. List those individuals who will be responsible for the implementation of the project/initiative and indicate their demonstrated abilities to accomplish the objectives of the project.

Tommy Tilley, Senior Technical Support Specialist, will assist and coordinate the installation and maintenance of equipment.

Hank Maddox, Maintenance for Leesville campus, will install the dry erase boards in classrooms.

8. Describe any personnel (technical or otherwise) required to support the project/initiative.

Computers for COMPASS testing will be housed in Martha Koury area where she will supervise usage.

Computers for Nursing Lab will be housed in room 21. Nursing personal, L. Nichols, W. Palermo, and D. Hickman will supervise these computers.

Computers for testing will be housed in room 111 and be supervised by C. Merchant who will be proctoring exams.

Computers housed in classrooms will be supervised by instructors teaching in the classrooms.

9. Provide a schedule for implementation and evaluation.

Equipment will be ordered in Sept. 2010 and arrive by the end of Oct. During the Fall 2010, the equipment will be installed in rooms and tested. Students will begin using equipment after the installation is complete.

10. Estimate the expected life of hardware and software. Explain any anticipated equipment/software upgrades during the next five years.

All equipment is expected to have a life of five years.

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



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
