## ADDENDUM

## DUAL DEGREE PROGRAM

The both universities will agree to provide a dual degree program: Students can transfer from one university to the other and meet graduation requirements to get bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees from the host universities. The host university will grant its bachelor's degree to the eligible students of the other university upon the successful completion of the program. In the first two years of study, the students of each university will study at their home university with its faculty, and in the last two years of study, the students will come to the campus of the host university to fulfill their bachelor's degree requirements for host universities.

Students will be required to meet the minimum credit hour standard of the host university in order to maintain status as full time students. Libre students will be charged the in-state tuition rate and NSU students will be charged matricula ordinaria. Students must complete all requirements of the host university such as Prerequisite requirements, General education, Core requirements and Major requirements in order to receive the degree from the host university. To fulfill these requirements, the duration of the program may exceed more than 2 years.

Libre students will allowed to transfer in the following courses for credit for Northwestern State University general education courses courses:
