This meeting is to review and approve grant proposals for the fiscal year 2003-2004. Each committee member was given the proposals prior to the meeting for each to review and have any questions or comments prepared. Greg started with meeting with turning the floor over to Jennifer to discuss each grant.

The committees approved the following as fully funded grant proposals.

#27 – Social Sciences in the amount of \$8,283.90; #23 – College of Business in the amount of \$36,923.16; #7 – Language/Communications in Ft. Polk in the amount of \$30,178.20; #15 – Criminal Justice in Ft. Polk and Natchitoches in the amount of \$12,605.00; #12 – Biology Sciences in Ft. Polk in the amount of \$14,520.00; #28 – Social Sciences in the amount of \$7,070.86; #24 – SGA Shreveport in the amount of \$500.00; #9 – Rad. Tech in Shreveport in the amount of \$16,145.00.

The committee approved the following as practically funded grant proposals.

#5 – Family and Consumer Sciences in the amount of \$19,577.12; #16 – Student Support Services in the amount of \$8,283.90; #14 – Journalism in the amount of \$20,380.55; #6 – Creative and Performing Arts in the amount of \$7,713.00; #3 – Creative and Performing Arts in the amount of \$8,192.00; #21 – Shreveport Campus (university must come up with 50% of the cost before tech fee money is released) in the amount of \$3,962.50.

All other grant proposals were not funded.
