Louisiana Pathways Early Learning Center Career Development System Overview

Louisiana Pathways Early Learning Center Career Development System is a statewide program designed to help early learning employees receive the recognition they deserve and to improve quality of early learning programs in Louisiana. Louisiana Pathways does not conduct training, but instead provides a means of tracking education and experience by providing registries for both early learning staff, and early care and education trainers.

Pathways promotes:

- Creating a quality workforce for early childhood programs by encouraging and supporting early childhood as a career.
- Reducing turnover in the field.
- Increasing the quality of programs for young children by raising the level of education for all early learning staff so children in Louisiana will have quality caregivers.

Components of Louisiana Pathways:

- Career Development Section
- Scholarship Section
- Trainer Approval Section
- CLASS Registry Section

Participation is voluntary and there are no fees for enrolling. However, individuals MUST be enrolled to be eligible for Louisiana's School Readiness Tax Credit for Directors and Staff.
